Consignments will be accepted by mail, email, fax, and phone according to the following schedules:

KEY AND UNIQUE ITEMS: before June 23, 2007 to provide time for special advertising. This category includes Real Estate over 100 years old, Antique Airplanes, Boats, Cars and Tractors, Oriental Rugs, Coin Operated Machines, Rare and Unusual Furniture, Coins, Jewelry, Local Olean Items and other high value items expected to bring over \$1,000. Please enclose pictures and descriptions - a requirement for this category.

ALL OTHER CONSIGNMENTS: before July 9, 2007.

CONSIGNED ITEMS may be delivered to the Jamestown Community College starting on **Tuesday, July 31, 2007** between 11 AM and 4 PM and no later than Thursday, August 2. No items will be accepted on Friday, August 3, 2007, as we will finalize set-up and begin the auction on Saturday, August 4 at 10 AM.

Warehouse space is available until auction and we can pick up items or receive them now! Call GOACC to make arrangements. Although every effort will be made to secure items dropped off before Tuesday, July 31st, any items brought before then are being left at the consignors own discretion (or risk).

AUCTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Individual items and lots will sell according to the following commission schedule:

- Lots selling for less than \$19.99 will be treated as a donation
- \$20.00-\$99.99 will incur a 30% commission
- \$100.00-\$999.99 will incur a 15% commission
- \$1000.00-\$9,999.99 will incur a 10% commission
- Lots selling for over \$10,000.00 will incur a 5% commission

(All commissions apply to individual lots only, not cumulative lots)

2. The above schedule is designed to encourage consignors to group items into lots that will maximize their profits. JCC Alumni and GOACC reserves the right and discretion to create or alter these groupings with the intent of benefiting the seller and the Auction as well as reject any consignments inappropriate for this sale.

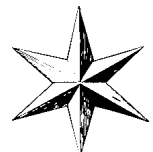
3. Commission checks shall be issued within two weeks of the conclusion of the auction. Sale prices for each item shall be available shortly after the conclusion of the auction on the website of the Greater Olean Chamber of Commerce at www.oleanny.com.

4. JCC Alumni and GOACC shall be responsible for bad checks and debts arising out of the auction. To the extent there are any auction items that are not paid for by the purchaser, JCC Alumni and GOACC will make an effort to contact the purchaser but shall not be held liable for unpaid auction items to any degree beyond returning the unpaid items to the Seller.

5. This is an ABSOLUTE AUCTION. This means: (1) the property shall be sold to the highest bidder without reserve; (2) no minimum bid is required; (3) the auction does not allow competing bids of any type by the seller or an agent of the seller; and (4) the seller cannot withdraw the property from auction after the auction is opened and there is public solicitation or calling for bids.

6. IF JCC Alumni or GOACC transports pianos or extra large items to the auction, the first \$150 in proceeds for the sale of those transported pianos/large items will be treated as a commission due to the labor and cost. The commission schedule will then follow the schedule described in Section 1.

7. JCC Alumni and GOACC shall permit absentee and/or telephone bidding on selected items at the discretion of the auctioneers.
