Program Cost

about jcc and the area:

Jamestown Community College, founded in 1950 as a predominantly transfer, liberal arts oriented institution, was among the first community colleges within the State University of New York. (SUNY) system. The campus is located on a 107-acre site in Jamestown, New York, which is located 80 miles south of Buffalo, NY. Jamestown, located in Chautauqua County, borders picturesque Chautauqua Lake and Lake Erie and is a tourist destination for all seasons. During the summer months the area is bustling with activity and features several points of interest including the famous Chautauqua Institution, Roger Tory Peterson Institute and is home to 30,000 acres of vineyards. The museums, resort centers and wineries, as well as events and festivals every weekend, make this a desirable, culturally rich destination.
