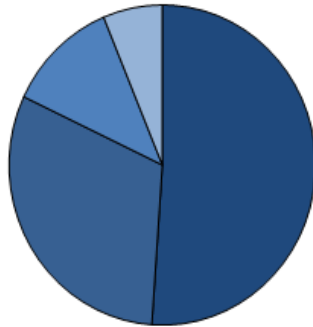

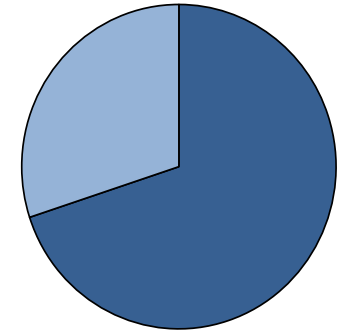

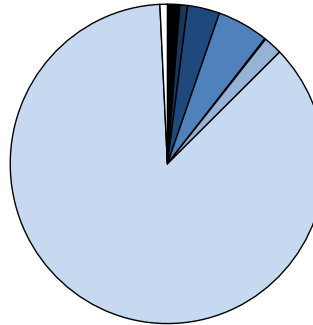

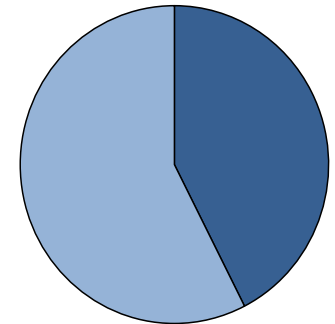

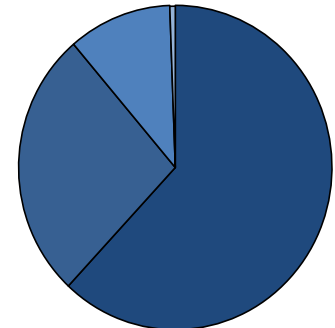

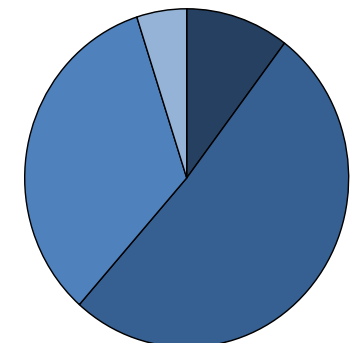
### Student Outcomes Class of 2009-2010\*
