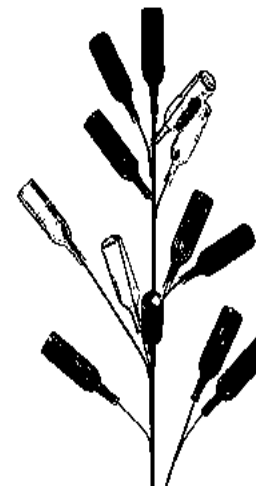

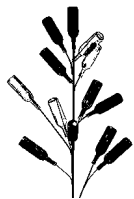

Felder will also close the workshop toying with garden art and the signing of his book, *Tough Plants for Northern Gardens*.
