**Instructor Profile: Mr. James Fischer**, a life-long resident of Chautauqua County, graduated from SUNY Fredonia, with undergraduate work in Biology and graduate work in Molecular Biology and Human Genetics. He worked for Chautauqua County for over 20 years, retiring in 2005 as a Senior Probation Officer. That same year he was diagnosed with Idiopathic Parkinson's Disease. Following his diagnosis he started a support group at Westfield Memorial Hospital. In 2008 Westfield Memorial Hospital was awarded a grant from the American Parkinson's Disease Association to establish an Information and Referral Center. Jim Fischer was named as Coordinator of that program. Mr. Fischer facilitates six support groups each month in addition to his other duties as Coordinator of the Center at Westfield Memorial Hospital.
