2. Please be familiar with the rules and regulations, as described in the **2009-2010 NJCAA Handbook & Casebook**, pertaining to golf **and Codes of Conduct and Tournament Decorum in National Tournaments**. These will be strictly enforced.
3. All participants should plan on playing through the last round on Friday. Travel plans should be made accordingly.
4. Payments for entry fee, banquet, chicken BBQ dinner, meal plans and tournament apparel can be made in advance or at registration. (Pre payment is appreciated and will ease the registration process.) Please remember to FAX the entry form **BEFORE** May 24, 2010, so we can include your roster in the tournament program.
5. Team expenses: Each college will be expected to pay for all expenses incurred by the school. Official tournament housing (team & individual) information is enclosed.
6. All players must have an adult coach/sponsor at the tournament that is designated by the college. Players reporting without proper sponsorship, as noted on the Certificate of Responsibility, will not be permitted to play or participate in practice rounds. All coach/sponsors must stay at same facility as student athletes.
7. All payment must be made in advance or at registration. **Jamestown Community College or FSA will not accept requisitions and/or purchase orders for tournament expenses**. Colleges failing to pay tournament costs by registration will not be permitted to participate.
8. The Golf School includes; driving range, putting greens, and sand and chipping areas. This will be available to all golfers and the designated coach. Mandatory cost is \$50.00/player.
9. All student athletes and coaches will receive complimentary memberships to Chautauqua Health, Fitness, and Tennis Center located across from Andriaccio's Restaurant during the week of the tournament!!

Housing

Chautauqua Golf Club, Chautauqua Vacation Properties Condominiums and the Chautauqua Suites Meeting and Expo Center will serve as official tournament sites.
