

JCC Honors Program

JCC's Honors Program provides stimulating academic opportunities for select students through additional challenges, supports, and ways to learn. Honors students enroll in special, honors-designated courses, engage in co-curricular activities, and take on fieldwork projects that synthesize academic and lived experiences.

Students who complete Honors Program requirements will receive an honors citation on their transcripts, along with other special graduation recognitions and student privileges.

Honors courses are developed by faculty who are dedicated to providing additional rigor and support for honors students. Courses may be "targeted" to honors students only or "blended" and offered to both honors and non-honors students.

Honors courses are indicated in the course schedule, and must have the following attributes: a focus on greater depth and breadth of subject matter; an interdisciplinary approach; strong attention to writing and critical thinking; and a strong focus on values and ethics.

New students with an 85% high school average who are eligible to take college-level English and MAT 1540, with a reading score of 80 or better, are eligible for the JCC Honors Program. Returning students who are eligible to take college-level English and MAT 1540 and have a GPA of 3.5 or better after 12 credit hours are Honors eligible.

Honors students must complete at least nine credit hours of honors-designated coursework; at least one of these credit hours must be an honors fieldwork or honors service learning course (see options below). Additionally, honors students must attend at least four approved honors engagement activities during their time at JCC. Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better and must not go more than one semester without enrolling in an honors course (excluding summer) in order to maintain honors eligibility.

Paperwork completed with the coordinator, a faculty mentor, and a site supervisor will initiate the registration process.
