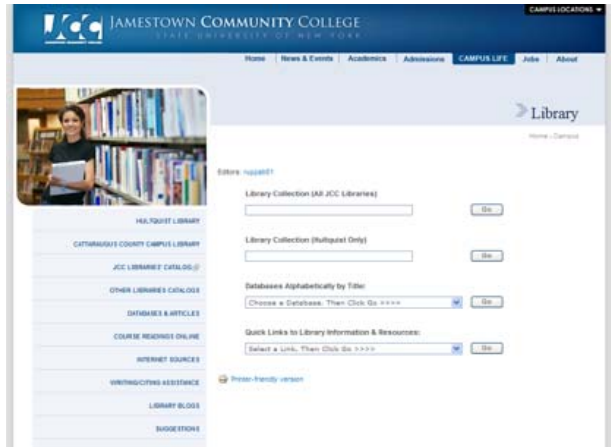




Off-Campus Access to Hultquist Library Electronic Resources



- Connect to the Library's Web page at:

<http://www.sunyjc.edu/library/>

- From the *Databases Alphabetically by Title*: drop down menu, select the database you want to use.

OR

- Click on the Databases & Articles link to connect to a page of full-text article databases and citation-only indexes.

- When you have selected a database that requires logging in (by clicking on its link), you will arrive at a *User Authentication* screen. (**IF YOU RECEIVE A SECURITY CERTIFICATE WARNING, CHOOSE TO CONTINUE TO THE WEB SITE. THE SITE IS SECURE.**)

- Following the on-screen instructions, enter your JCC student username and password, and click on *Submit Query*.

- You will now be connected to the database you selected.

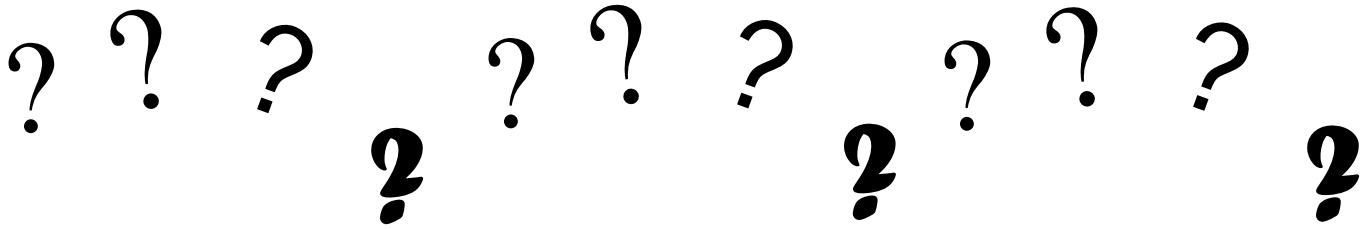

Who?

Any **CURRENT** full- or part-time JCC student, faculty or staff can use the Library databases remotely.

When?

The Library databases are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Individual databases may be unavailable occasionally for maintenance and upgrades.

Where?

The Library Web pages provide links to available databases. The databases used to locate *periodical articles* can be found on the Databases & Articles page on the Library Web page at <http://www.sunyjcc.edu/library>.

Why?

Remote access gives JCC students, faculty and staff access to a variety of library resources when it is convenient for them, not just during hours the library is open.

How?

To access the Library databases, you must have an active username/password and abide by the college's Computer Use Policy. **ACCOUNTS ARE AVAILABLE TO CURRENT JCC STUDENTS, FACULTY AND STAFF ONLY.**

Your student username is made up of:

- The first 6 letters of your last name (If your name has fewer than 6 letters, you will use all of them)
- The first letter of your first name
- The first letter of your middle name if you have one
- Add a 01 at the end (for more common names, the last digit will be changed to avoid duplication)

Your password is your birth date in the form MMDDYY.

Examples:	Student Name	Username	Birth Date	Password
	Jane Marie Anderson	andersjm01	January 7, 1989	010789
	John Mark Anderson	andersjm02	May 16, 1972	051672
	Joyce Marian Anderson	andersjm03	November 23, 1990	112390
