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Articulation Agreement

Jamestown Community College

And

Buffalo State College

Section I Summary

This agreement constitutes an agreement between Jamestown Community College and Buffalo State College. Students accepted to specific academic majors at Jamestown Community College are eligible to enroll in this cooperative program. Students, who wish to enroll at Buffalo State College based on this agreement, must be matriculated at Jamestown Community College. Further, students will, upon completion of the prescribed sequence of courses leading to an associate's degree from Jamestown Community College, immediately continue their studies at Buffalo State College with the understanding that they will be given the opportunity to complete all requirements in a parallel baccalaureate degree program in four semesters of full-time study at Buffalo State College unless otherwise specified in Appendix 1. This assumes the completion of the required credit hours, required grade point average (GPA), and any pre-requisite courses for acceptance into the major. Some baccalaureate degrees generally take more than eight total semesters of coursework to complete. In most cases, students who transfer from Jamestown Community College will have the opportunity to complete these degrees in the same total number of semesters as native students who take all of their coursework at Buffalo State College. A maximum of 66 credits may transfer into Buffalo State College from Jamestown Community College.

Such students may select any Buffalo State major designated as parallel to their chosen major at Jamestown Community College. Jamestown Community College's major programs and corresponding Buffalo State College programs are listed in Appendix 2. With few exceptions, students who wish to change their major upon enrolling at Buffalo State College may do so after their first semester

at Buffalo State College and with the understanding that they may need more than four additional full-time semester to earn their baccalaureate degree. Students who wish to change their major at Jamestown Community College after submitting the Intent to Enroll form should contact the Office of Admissions at Buffalo State College. Students will be reviewed to determine if they are eligible for the Articulation program and, if approved, may need more than four additional full-time semester to earn their baccalaureate degree.

Section II Identifying Potential Students

Jamestown Community College will make this Agreement available on its website. Students who initially indicate their interest in Buffalo State College to the Admissions Office or the Counseling and Career Development Center at Jamestown Community College, will be directed by those offices to the Agreement. For students who initially indicate an interest in Buffalo State to a JCC academic advisor, JCC will encourage advisors to direct those students to the Buffalo State website.

To be eligible for coverage under the terms of this Agreement, students must apply before completion of 30 college credit hours. Students selected by Buffalo State College will normally be first-time full-time students at Jamestown Community College with no prior non-JCC credits. However, upon application by the student to and at the discretion of Buffalo State College, some returning students, or those who earned college credit from a school other than Jamestown Community College while attending high school, may be allowed entry into the program.

Section III Application Requirements

Jamestown Community College students interested in the Agreement are not required to file an application for admission to Buffalo State College. However, students who anticipate enrolling at Buffalo State College under the auspices of this agreement must file an **Intent to Enroll** form with the office of admissions at Buffalo State College by February 1st to begin their studies at Buffalo State College for the summer and fall semesters, and by October 1st to begin their studies at Buffalo State College for the spring semester.

A tuition deposit will not be required of participants who have filed the **Intent to Enroll** form by the designated date. However, students who wish to reside in the campus residence halls will be required to submit a \$200 housing deposit by June 1st for the fall semester and will be billed for the spring semester at the time of spring registration.

Section IV Entrance Requirements

Admission requirements into the major, including courses required for entry into the major and/or pre-requisites for the major, must be completed and be present on the transcript from Jamestown Community College at the time the student files an **Intent to Enroll** form showing that the student earned the minimum grade required for the course(s). Any pre-requisites required by the major at Buffalo State College have been scheduled on the curriculum sequence sheets during the first year at Jamestown Community College. Major course requirements for the bachelor's degree will be those in effect at the time the student formally registers at Buffalo State College. The candidate must meet the required grade point average to enter into the major at Buffalo State College.

Jamestown Community College students are expected to meet the same requirements as internal students at Buffalo State College.

Section V Housing

Jamestown Community College students will be guaranteed on-campus housing at Buffalo State College during all four semesters at Buffalo State College. However, students are not required to live on campus.

Section VI Student Academic Advisement

Jamestown Community College will assume responsibility for advising students who participate in the Agreement, and who also inform their advisor at each student/advisor meeting to schedule classes that they have been accepted by

Buffalo State College under the terms of this agreement and are required to take courses specified in the agreement. The transfer course equivalency table (https://banner.buffalostate.edu:8585/pls/PROD/ywsktrar.P_Dispatches), and curriculum sequence sheets (<http://www.buffalostate.edu/admissions/documents/pgmlistjcc.pdf>) will be used as the mechanism for communicating degree requirements to students. Curriculum sequence sheets will be available on Buffalo State College's website. They will include a list of courses to be taken at Jamestown Community College, the Buffalo State College equivalent of those courses, and a list of remaining courses that will be required to fulfill baccalaureate degree requirements at Buffalo State College. Equivalencies will be reviewed annually and appropriate revisions made if either institution adds, deletes, or changes course requirements.

Staff members from Buffalo State College will provide an information workshop/ advisement for students in the articulation agreement program. New students are strongly encouraged to contact the department of their intended major at Buffalo State College prior to registration for their first full-time semester at Buffalo State College. Whenever possible, Buffalo State College will provide on-site support to Jamestown Community College students.

In addition, Buffalo State College agrees to provide a training session, upon request, for the faculty and staff at Jamestown Community College who will be involved in consulting with and advising students enrolled in this program.

Students who have completed 30 credit hours of non-remedial coursework at Jamestown Community College may take one major course per semester at Buffalo State College with no additional cost for full time students (defined as students who take at least 12 credit hours at Jamestown Community College) in order to fulfill an elective or major requirement during their third and/or fourth semester of study at Jamestown Community College. Cross-registration forms would need to be completed and are available in the registration/records office at the community college. The student must have earned the minimum GPA required by the department of study at Buffalo State College and be registered as a full time student during that semester at Jamestown Community College. Certain courses may require the approval of the appropriate chairperson at Buffalo State College.

The course selection is at the direction of the department in which they plan to earn their baccalaureate degree at Buffalo State College.

Section VII Information Sharing & Submission of Transcripts

Students will submit an initial official transcript from Jamestown Community College to Buffalo State College Office of Admissions no later than the deadline for submission of the Intent to Enroll form. The student will provide official student transcripts from all previous colleges and/or documentation of advanced credit to Buffalo State College as requested.

Students must also submit an official transcript upon completion of the courses for the Associate Degree at Jamestown Community College with the degree posted. This transcript must be submitted as soon as the degree is posted on the student's academic record.

Section VIII Time Frame and Provisions for Program Review

All full-time students currently enrolled at Jamestown Community College and those admitted to begin their studies at Jamestown Community College from June 2010 to May 2012 are eligible to be considered for this articulation program.
