

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT IN INFORMATION SYSTEMS  
BETWEEN  
JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
AND  
MEDAILLE COLLEGE

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Jamestown Community College and Medaille College. Its purpose is to afford students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers, and to facilitate the transfer process from Jamestown Community College to the Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) Information Systems degree program at Medaille College. The program is an online degree completion program for working adults. Students meet the NYSED requirements for online learning time through individual and group activities. Students must have access to an appropriate computer and Internet connection.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF ADMISSION, STANDING, AND TRANSFER OF COURSES

Students who graduate from Jamestown Community College with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree, an Associate in Science (A.S.) degree, or an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree, and who have also achieved a minimum cumulative Jamestown Community College grade point average of 2.5, are guaranteed admission with full junior status into the B.B.A. Information Systems degree program at Medaille College. Students transfer as many as 68 credit hours toward fulfillment of Medaille degree requirements.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF OPPORTUNITY TO GRADUATE

Students are guaranteed the opportunity to earn the bachelor's degree with the completion of the required Core course sequence through Medaille College. Other Medaille requirements, and Jamestown Community College/Medaille College course equivalencies, are included in Appendix A. Students who have completed all 68 credit hours listed in the "JCC Portion" of Appendix B are guaranteed the opportunity to earn the bachelor's degree in two years with the equivalent of four continuous semesters of full-time study at the normal coursework rate of 12 or more credits per term at Medaille College.

PROMOTION OF AGREEMENT

Both parties have the right to use this agreement and the names of Jamestown Community College and Medaille College in all promotional activities including college catalogs and recruitment or advisement activities.

PROVISION FOR CHANGES IN POLICIES OR CURRICULA

Proposed changes in policies or curricula by either party should be communicated in writing to the other party.

PROVISION FOR CANCELLATION

Either party may independently cancel this agreement by notifying the other party in writing no less than one year before the intended date of cancellation.
