

## **- Articulation Agreement -**

### **BACHELOR IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BBA) in TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT**

#### **JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE and ALFRED STATE COLLEGE**

#### **Purpose of Agreement**

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Jamestown Community College and Alfred State College. Its purpose is to afford students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers, and to facilitate the transfer process from Jamestown Community College to the Bachelor in Business Administration (B.B.A.) degree program in Technology Management at Alfred State College.

#### **General Guarantee of Admission and Standing**

Students who

- graduate from Jamestown Community College with an Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.), or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree,
- have fulfilled at least five SUNY General Education Requirements,
- have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0, and
- have a computer (laptop or otherwise) that meets Alfred State college baseline requirements.

are guaranteed admission into the B.B.A. Technology Management degree program at Alfred State College. They are also guaranteed full junior status.

Students who do not meet all of the above criteria will be evaluated for acceptance on a case by case basis.

#### **General Guarantee of Opportunity to Graduate**

Students who graduate from Jamestown Community College with an A.A., A.S., or A.A.S. degree are guaranteed the opportunity to earn the bachelor's degree with four semesters of normal coursework with Alfred State College.

### **Other Information**

Students who earn an A.A., A.S., or A.A.S. degree from Jamestown Community College will automatically receive 60 transfer credit hours from Alfred State College toward the requirements for the B.B.A. Technology Management degree. Additional Jamestown Community College coursework can increase the amount of transfer credit to a maximum of all 78 lower level credit hours required for the bachelor's degree. Appendix A lists requirements for the bachelor's degree, and also lists coursework that can be transferred from Jamestown Community College.

For the eighth semester internship, a JCC representative will be available to advise Alfred State College's appointed coordinator regarding local internship opportunities and contacts.

**Additional Graduation Requirements:**

- Total minimum credit hours for graduation is 127, including one credit hour of physical education.
- A cumulative overall index of at least 2.0 is required in order to graduate.
- General education electives should come from any of the 10 general education silos not already fulfilled.
- You may cross register for one course per semester at Alfred University at no additional expense.
- Twelve credit hours may be transferred back within a seven year period if you leave Alfred prior to completing your degree.
- Thirty credit hours of the 45 upper level credit hours for this degree must be taken at Alfred.
- This curriculum meets 10 out of 10 SUNY General Education requirements.
- Be sure to check for prerequisite requirements when scheduling courses.
- You should meet frequently with your academic advisor.
- Accommodations will be offered to students who are unable to fulfill internship requirements.

**Admission Requirements:** Students must either possess an associate’s degree or have amassed at least 60 credit hours toward a degree, including courses that fulfill five different general education fields.
