Dr. Kochersberger is a Research Associate Professor of mechanical engineering at Virginia Tech and a 1,500+-hour pilot. He played a key role in the 100th anniversary reenactment of the Wright Brothers first flight at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina, on December 17, 2003.

To be eligible to apply, a student must:

- **be enrolled in the AAS Professional Piloting degree**
- **have completed a minimum of one full-time semester at JCC (*or through the articulation agreements with Genesee, Monroe or Erie Community College) at the time of application**
- **have a minimum GPA of 3.0**

This \$250 scholarship is to be applied toward the recipient's next tuition bill at Jamestown Community College.
