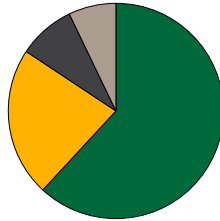

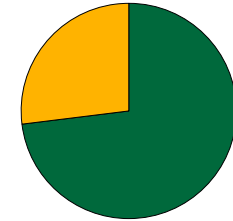

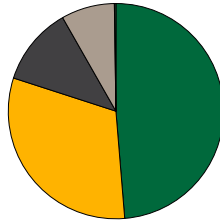
Student Status

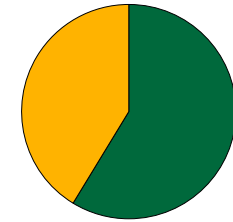

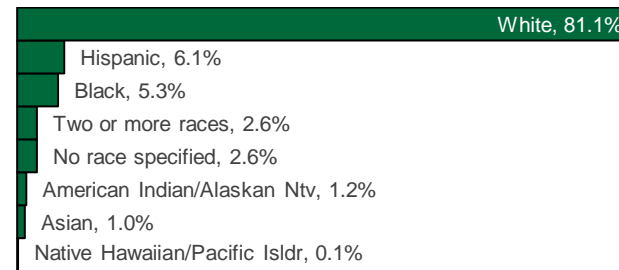

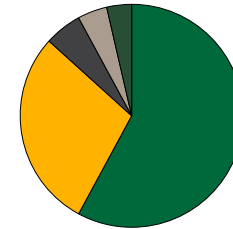

59% of graduates were employed full time or pursuing further education within six months of graduation.

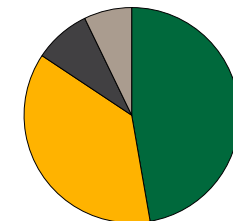
