<input type="checkbox"/> Jamestown Campus Sophomore Student Senator (multiple positions) <i>Student Senate members serve as representatives of the general student body. They interact regularly with faculty, staff, and administration, as well as clubs and student organizations. Senators are asked to provide input on college committees and be the voice of the student body. Senate members are expected to attend meetings every Friday from 12:00 - 2:00 PM and participate in service projects. Senate members also provide a minimum of one office hour a week in the Senate Office and may also serve on a senate sub-committee. Officer positions are described in the Student Constitution.</i>	Part-time or Full-time students Sophomore status (completed 24 college credit hours as of June 2017)
<input type="checkbox"/> Student Senate NORTH COUNTY Representative (two vacancies) <i>The North County Center is represented by Student Senate, and it is critical that a North County student represent the voice of the extension center. The North County Senator does NOT have to travel to Jamestown to participate in Senate meetings but may be cross-registered at both locations. Distance Learning technology is available to attend the meetings from Dunkirk. (See requirements above)</i>	Freshman or Sophomore status as of Fall 2017 Part-time or Full-time student
<input type="checkbox"/> Student Trustee (one position) <i>The Student Trustee is a voting member of the JCC Board of Trustees and represents the JCC student body college-wide (Jamestown Campus, Catt. County Campus and the North County Extension Center). The Student Trustee is expected to attend monthly board of trustees meetings, may be appointed to sub-committees, and regularly gives an oral report to the board on Student Senate, student life, and campus events. The Student Trustee is also a non-voting member of the Student Senate and is expected to attend all Friday meetings.</i>	Sophomore status (completed 24 college credit hours as of June 2017) Full-time student at either the Jamestown Campus, North County Extension Center or Cattaraugus County Campus
<input type="checkbox"/> Faculty Student Association Executive Board (two vacancies) <i>FSA Executive Board meets once a month and oversees the organization's functional areas such as Campus Stores, Food Services, Residence Life operations, Fitness operations, Capital Equipment, and personnel. The Executive Board meets one Friday per month at NOON - 1:30 p.m., normally the 3rd Friday of the month from September - April. May's meeting is normally the 2nd Friday.</i>	Full-time student at either the Jamestown Campus or North County Extension Center Freshman or Sophomore status as of Fall 2017
<input type="checkbox"/> Faculty Student Association Activity Board (three vacancies) <i>FSA Activity Board meets once a month and oversees the organization's student activity fees funding such departments as Student Senate, Campus Life, the College Program Committee, JCC theatre and art programming, varsity sports, and Commencement.</i>	2 Full-time students from Jamestown Campus or NCEC Part-time student Freshman or Sophomore status as of Fall 2017
<input type="checkbox"/> Student Affairs Committee (up to three students may be appointed) <i>The Student Affairs Committee is comprised of faculty, staff, and students and is primarily concerned with facilitating student appeals for student conduct and academic integrity violations. In addition, any changes or updates to the Student Constitution are initiated through the Student Affairs Committee. Finally, the Committee acts as a vehicle for student concerns about JCC policy and process in order to reach more formal levels of the organization. Meetings will take place from Noon - 1:00 p.m. on Sept 15, Oct 20, Nov 17, Dec 15, Jan 19, Feb 16, Mar 16, Apr 20, and May 18.</i>	Part-time or Full-time students Freshman or Sophomore status as of Fall 2017

In keeping with its charges, the committee makes a special effort to support on-campus events and activities that extend students' perceptions of other people, the world, and their place in the world. - All candidates' semester and cumulative GPAs will be checked before their names appear on the ballot to ensure they meet the **minimum 2.0 GPA** requirement.
- Sophomore status is defined as 24 credit hours completed.
- Candidates may cast a ballot, but they **cannot solicit by word** or presence within the defined areas adjacent to the voting area.
- ONLY Student Senators **not** listed on the ballot may be seated at the election table.
- Votes will be tallied by the President and Elections Chair, or their appointees.
