

Steps to take prior to your arrival on Move-In Day, Saturday, August 26, 2017

As a reminder, the bill for housing, tuition and fees is due on August 25, 2017. Student bills can be viewed in the secure area of BANNER at www.sunyjcc.edu/myjcc. Please be aware that to be eligible to receive keys and participate in Move-In Day on Saturday, August 26, 2017, students will need to be registered for classes and demonstrate that they have taken the appropriate measures to pay their bill in full by means of *personal payment, financial aid, and/or enrollment in the College's Nelnet payment plan.*

Approved financial aid has been applied to your account:

Student or Parent PLUS loans may be necessary to cover all of your expenses. A student loan acceptance form or parent PLUS loan application should be submitted ***no later than August 1st*** so that these funds are available on time for your bill. Check your financial aid status in BANNER to assure you have completed all requirements to receive your anticipated aid www.sunyjcc.edu/myjcc. If your aid is delayed, enrollment in the Nelnet payment plan will allow you to move into the residence halls while you finish the financial aid and loan processes. **Please be aware that financial aid takes 6–8 weeks to process, if you are filing after July 1, late charges may be applied to your account balance.*

Please be aware that Nelnet has many options and deadlines for reduced monthly payments.

Your enrollment in the Nelnet plan:

- ♦ by July 21st requires a down payment of 10% of your account balance.
- ♦ by Aug 24th requires a down payment of 25% of your account balance.
- ♦ after August 24th requires a down payment of 50% of your account balance**

**All College balances are dues on August 25th, late fees could be assessed on all accounts Past the August 25th due date.

Enrolling in the Nelnet plan ***will not*** reduce your eligibility to receive any financial aid for which you are applying. Any financial aid received ***after your enrollment*** in the plan ***will be applied to your bill***, and will ***reduce future payments in equal amounts***. If your aid is greater than your remaining installments, you will be refunded any excess funds you have paid on your account.

Message to All Students:

Residence Life is all about our students being responsible and making good choices. Failure to complete your financial aid/loan applications or pay subsequent Nelnet monthly installments may result in eviction from the Residence Halls until the balance is paid in full, with charges remaining in accordance to the College's refund schedule. It is important to remind you that your continued eligibility to receive financial aid for the spring semester ***will*** depend upon you meeting minimum satisfactory academic progress requirements. You must make the choice to attend your classes and put forth the effort to excel in your classes. Residence Life staff members are here to support and guide your success into the future!
