Course Title: Creative Ceramics

Course Abbreviation and Number: ART 1600

Credit Hours: 1 credit hour.

Course Type: Lecture/Lab

Course Description: This course is designed mainly for intermediate level students and community members. Students will develop skills with potter's wheel, hand building methods, glazing, decoration techniques, and kiln operations.

Prerequisite: ART 1590.
