**Course Title:** The Gothic Novel

Course Abbreviation and Number: ENG 2570

**Credit Hours: 3** 

Course Type: Lecture

**Course Description:** Students will trace the history of Gothic literature starting with Horace Walpole's novel The Castle or Otranto. Significant attention will be given to the influence of the Gothic novel in writing throughout the Romantic and Victorian ages and Modern literature. In addition to literature, students will also explore Gothic influences on architecture, art, film, and popular culture.

Prerequisite: ENG 1530.

- 1. Identify and analyze Gothic characteristics in literature and other art forms.
- 2. Trace the impact of Gothic literature on other types and genres of literature.
- 3. Analyze the sociohisotorical influces that led to Gothic literature.

- The Gothic Novel and the Victorian Age
- Southern Gothic
- Contemporary Gothic

- The intersections of the Gothic genre with horror writing and film
