Course Title: Medical Terminology

Course Description: Focuses on medical terminology as it occurs in the anatomical systems of the human body. Students will learn the basic principles of medical word building, pronunciation, and use of medical terms. Students will also learn about all human anatomical systems, the study of common diseases, procedures, and abnormalities.

- 6. Explain the use of prefixes in medical terminology and how a prefix changes the meaning of a medical word.
- 7. Demonstrate an understanding of the disease process by defining medical terms associated with the body systems.
- 8. Identify diagnostic, symptomatic, surgical and therapeutic terms and procedures related to the body systems.
- 9. Identify and discuss pathology related to each body system.
