- Calculate target heart rate for a minute
- Calculate target heart rate range
- Introduction to the F.I. T.T. principle
- Introduction to warm-up and cool-down phases of exercise
- Instruction to the components of health related fitness as it relates to flexibility
- Introduction to abdominal/core strength program
- Introduction to several different walking programs
