License Agreement and Terms:

- The cost of housing for the summer 2017 session is \$645.00 per summer session. Payments are due by the published payment deadlines. Students who fail to make payment by the due date(s) may have an academic hold placed on their account or their housing contract cancelled. ****For those students who wish to remain in Residence between sessions, there will be an additional \$75 charge.***
- Occupants agree that housing and tuition fees will be paid by due dates and accept liability for any collection costs as a result of failure to pay including, without limitation, collection agency fees, court costs and attorney fees. Occupants must understand that if any portion of their account remains unpaid at the end of the semester, their account will be forwarded to a collection agency within 30 – 90 days. Occupants must also understand that Jamestown Community College may contact them by phone, e-mail, or text message regarding any outstanding account balance using any phone number, cell phone number or e-mail that was provided to the college.
- I understand that if I choose not to be a responsible resident, I will face disciplinary action. If found responsible for actions causing damage to the residence hall or surrounding property, I will be liable to pay damages and face possible expulsion from JCC Hillside Suites Residence Halls and the JCC Residence Life Program.
- All residence halls on the JCC Jamestown Campus are alcohol, tobacco and drug free. Residents who are found in possession of or knowingly in the presence of any of the aforementioned items may jeopardize their stay in the JCC Residence Halls. Violations of policies will be subject to judicial sanctions, as outlined by the Student Code of Conduct contained within the Constitution of the Student Body.
- Summer Guest Policy:** All JCC Residence Halls are 24/7 quiet hour facilities. Due to the demand of a summer session schedule, overnight guests are not permitted Sunday through Thursday nights. All guests must vacate the halls by midnight. If a situation requires an overnight guest, it must be approved by the Residence Director on duty prior to the guest staying the night. All overnight guests on the weekend, must be approved by the Residence Director, and signed in for accountability purposes. All guests must be over the age of 17 and have a valid form of identification. Residents are responsible for the behavior of their guests and escorting them throughout the building, if they travel outside of the suite.
- All JCC students must remain at six (6) credit hours per summer session to be considered full time. Full time status is required at all times during the summer session(s) to remain in residence. Should a student fall below full time status, they may be asked to leave the residence halls.
- It is understood that you accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this license and that you are responsible for adherence to all other policies specified in the FSA On-Campus Living Policies and the Constitution of the Student Body. These documents can be found on our website and will be published and located inside of each residence hall and the residence life office, on campus. Upon signing and submitting this Housing Application and License Agreement, **I acknowledge that I have reviewed this housing application and license and understand that I am responsible for its contents and the policies upheld by the College, all as may be amended from time-to-time in the sole discretion of FSA and the College.**
