

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT IN PSYCHOLOGY  
BETWEEN  
JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
AND  
DAEMEN COLLEGE

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

This document establishes a transfer articulation agreement between Jamestown Community College (JCC) and Daemen College (Daemen). Its purpose is to afford students the opportunity to pre-plan their college careers, and to facilitate the transfer process from the Associate in Arts (A.A.) Liberal Arts & Sciences: Social Sciences degree program at JCC to the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) Psychology degree program at Daemen.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF ADMISSION AND STANDING

Students who graduate with an A.A. Liberal Arts & Sciences: Social Sciences degree from JCC and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 are guaranteed admission with full junior standing to the B.A. Psychology degree program at Daemen.

GENERAL GUARANTEE OF OPPORTUNITY TO GRADUATE

Students who graduate from JCC having taken all 60 credits of coursework listed in the body of Appendix A of this agreement will have the opportunity to earn the bachelor's degree in four semesters of coursework at Daemen.

Students beginning their research sequence at Daemen are required to receive a C or better in each research sequence course. Students are allowed one retake of each course for which a grade below C is earned. Additional semester(s) *may* be required if students need to repeat required courses in the research sequence.

TRANSFER OF COURSES FROM JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Daemen will accept up to the equivalent of 90 credits (see the body of Appendix A and the \* regarding free electives) in transfer from JCC toward fulfillment of requirements for the B.S. Psychology degree, leaving as few as 32 credits to be taken at Daemen.
