

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
COLLEGE AT ONEONTA
AND JAMESTOWN COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE SPORT MANAGEMENT (A.S.)
ARTICULATED TO
*SUNY ONEONTA SPORT MANAGEMENT (B.S)***

This agreement is intended to facilitate the transition of graduates of an associate degree program at Jamestown Community College to a baccalaureate degree program at SUNY Oneonta. SUNY Oneonta recognizes its particular responsibility to students from its surrounding region, as well as from the rest of New York State, to insure a smooth transition from a two-year institution. SUNY Oneonta has made a strong commitment to help transfer students maximize their opportunities.

AGREEMENT

1. Jamestown Community College students who have graduated or who will graduate with an Associate in Science (A.S.) in Sport Management, and who apply by the deadline and meet the admission criteria published in the current SUNY Oneonta college catalog, will be admitted to the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree program in Sport Management as matriculated students with junior status at SUNY Oneonta.
2. Table 1 shows Jamestown Community College A.S. Sport Management degree requirements and SUNY Oneonta equivalent courses. As detailed in Table 2, SUNY Oneonta will accept a maximum of 75 semester hours (s.h.) from Jamestown Community College toward fulfilling B.S. Sport Management degree requirements. 3. SUNY Oneonta will advise Jamestown Community College of any changes to the Jamestown Community College/SUNY Oneonta course equivalencies listed in this agreement.
4. This agreement is not to be considered contractual. Students are advised to consult both the Jamestown Community College and SUNY Oneonta college catalogs regarding any modifications or changes to program requirements.

To be assured admittance to the B.S. Sport Management program at SUNY Oneonta under the terms of this agreement, all students must:

- be in good academic and student standing with Jamestown Community College,
- have a minimum Jamestown Community College cumulative grade point average (gpa) of 2.5,
- have completed and been awarded the A.S. Sport Management degree,
- have followed the prescribed process in applying to SUNY Oneonta and furnished a final transcript with the degree posted, and
- have earned grades of “D-” or better in any coursework that is to be transferred.

Exceptions to the above requirements may be made by SUNY Oneonta on a case-by-case basis.

Upon acceptance to SUNY Oneonta, students who are transferring into the B.S. in Sport Management with a Jamestown Community College A.S. Sport Management degree will:

- be provided a transfer credit evaluation and advisement document outlining coursework to be completed,
- be awarded junior status,
- be considered for all Transfer Scholarships available through the Office of Admissions without filing any additional paperwork, and
- be advised toward the successful completion of degree requirements by their academic department.

SUNY Oneonta will extend every opportunity to help students who begin their SUNY Oneonta courses in a fall semester complete the B.S. Sport Management degree in two additional years of full time study.
