

PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
between
**Department of Kinesiology, Sport Studies and Physical Education, SUNY College at
Brockport**
and
Jamestown Community College

I. INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the State University of New York's transfer policy the document herewith has been drafted between Jamestown Community College and the SUNY College at Brockport's Department of Kinesiology, Sport Studies and Physical Education. The intent is to facilitate students of Jamestown Community College transferring to SUNY College at Brockport and adopting the Physical Education Teacher Education major.

Please note that this agreement does not guarantee acceptance by either The College at Brockport or The College's Physical Education Teacher Education major.

II. TRANSFER TO SUNY COLLEGE AT BROCKPORT

The number of hours to be transferred and the allocation of such hours shall be determined by the following policies:

A. Total Transfer Credit

1. Transfer Students Holding an Associate Degree

Students holding an approved transfer associate degree from a regionally accredited college may transfer up to 64 credits. Such students will automatically be granted at least 60 credits and junior status. Some students, such as those seeking teacher certification, may need more than 60 additional credits to complete the baccalaureate degree requirements depending on previous courses and the major and other academic programs selected at SUNY Brockport.

2. Students without an Associate Degree

Subject to evaluation, students without an associate degree may transfer up to 64 credits and be granted junior status.

III. CONSIDERATION FOR TRANSFER TO THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHER EDUCATION MAJOR

- A. To qualify for admission to the Physical Education Teacher Education major at SUNY Brockport, Jamestown Community College graduates must submit a successful application and official transcript to SUNY Brockport's Office of Undergraduate Admissions no later than May 1 for fall admission and November 1 for spring admission, and achieve a cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- B. The normal length of time from transfer to degree completion for JCC graduates who have completed the SUNY General Education program is five semesters, which includes a semester of student teaching. Brockport program advisors will make every effort to help transfer students complete their degrees as quickly as possible.
- C. Completion of the following courses at Jamestown Community College is recommended:

1. SUNY General Education program and

2. Brockport General Education Local Requirements that can be completed at JCC.
