

# PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

**Art Department, The College at Brockport**

and

**Jamestown Community College**

## I. INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

In compliance with the State University of New York's transfer policy, the document herewith has been drafted between Jamestown Community College and The College at Brockport's Art Department. The intent is to facilitate graduates of the Jamestown Community College Associate in Science (AS) Fine Arts: Studio Arts degree program transferring to The College at Brockport and adopting the Bachelor of Fine Art (BFA) Studio Art major or the Bachelor of Art/Bachelor of Science (BA/BS) Studio Art major.

Please note that this agreement does not guarantee acceptance by either The College at Brockport or into The College's BFA Studio Art or BA/BS Studio Art major.

## II. TRANSFER TO SUNY COLLEGE AT BROCKPORT

The number of hours to be transferred and the allocation of such hours shall be determined by the following policies:

### A. Total Transfer Credit

#### 1. From two-year colleges.

- a. Students holding the AS Fine Arts: Studio Arts degree may transfer up to 64 credits. Such students will automatically be granted at least 60 credits and junior status. AS Fine Arts: Studio Arts graduates who have successfully completed
  - The SUNY general education requirement of 30 credits in Basic Communications, Mathematics, and 5 of the 8 of the remaining SUNY general education requirements, and
  - ART 1510 Drawing I, ART 1530 2-D Design and Color, ART 1540 3-D Design/Concepts/Materials, ART 1550 Survey of Visual Art: Prehistoric-Medieval, and ART 1560 Survey of Visual Art: Renaissance-Contemporary will be able to earn the BFA Studio Art or the BA/BS Studio Art degree in four semesters at SUNY Brockport. See below for various Jamestown Community College/The College at Brockport art course equivalencies.
- b. Students without an associate degree from a regionally accredited college may transfer up to 64 credits and be granted junior status.

c. Transfer students who alter their educational plans after acceptance by The College at Brockport should be aware that some students may need more than 60 additional credits to complete baccalaureate degree requirements, depending upon previous coursework and upon the major and other academic programs selected at The College at Brockport.

2. **From four-year colleges.** A total of 90 credits may be accepted for transfer from any regionally accredited four-year college or university.

### III. CONSIDERATION FOR TRANSFER TO THE ART DEPARTMENT

- A. To qualify for admission to the BFA StudioArt major or the BA/BS Studio Art major at the College at Brockport, Jamestown Community College graduates must submit a successful application and official transcript to Brockport's Office of Undergraduate Admissions no later than May 1 for fall admission and November 1 for spring admission.
- B. If applying for immediate entry into the BFA program, Jamestown Community College graduates must also submit a BFA program application prior to their first semester at The College at Brockport, by March 1 for fall admission and October 1 for spring admission. They can also choose to apply to the BFA program after transfer to The College at Brockport.
- C. A maximum of 21 transfer credits may be applied to the major. Only courses with grades of "C-" or better may be used toward the major.
- D. Applicants are strongly encouraged to complete the following BFA and BA/BS Studio Art degree requirements at Jamestown Community College:

ART 1510 Drawing I (equivalent to ART 221 Drawing I)

ART 1530 2-D Design and Color (equivalent to ART 210 2-D Design)

ART 1540 3-D Design/Concepts/Materials (equivalent to ART 212 3-D Design)

ART 1550 Survey of Visual Art: Prehistoric-Medieval (equivalent to ARH 201 World Art I)

ART 1560 Survey of Visual Art: Renaissance-Contemporary (equivalent to ARH 202 World Art II)
