

**PATHWAYS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF
STUDENTS FROM JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE INTO THE
BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS AT STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
AT EMPIRE STATE COLLEGE**

This Pathways articulation agreement assures that students who complete an Associate in Arts (A.A.), Associate in Science (A.S.), or Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree (hereinafter referred to as associate degree) at Jamestown Community College and who also meet all admissions requirements as published in the current Empire State College catalog are able to transfer to Empire State College. This agreement provides a seamless transition for graduates of Jamestown Community College into an appropriate Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Bachelor of Science (B.S.), or Bachelor of Professional Studies (B.P.S.) degree program at Empire State College.

Terms of Agreement

1. Empire State College agrees to admit students who successfully complete an associate degree at Jamestown Community College and meet Empire State College's published admissions requirements into the Empire State College bachelor's degree program of their choice. (An exception to this guarantee of admission is Empire State College's nursing program, which is selective and has additional program specific admission requirements.) Empire State College also agrees to accept the entire associate degree from Jamestown Community College toward meeting requirements for any parallel bachelor's degree. See Appendix A for a listing of parallel Jamestown Community College/Empire State College degrees.
2. Empire State College faculty mentors will work with new Pathways students to allow for enrollment at Jamestown Community College in additional courses. With appropriate advising, the student can complete 79 lower-division credits (including the associate degree) at the community college as long as the courses meet bachelor's degree requirements. The remaining 45 upper-division credits will be completed with Empire State College, and can be completed in four semesters. Empire State College will also work with Jamestown Community College to provide 1) pre-matriculation advisement for students, 2) information sessions for students, and 3) program information outreach and training for faculty and transfer office staff.

Appendix A: Jamestown Community College / Empire State College Parallel Degree Programs

The following Jamestown Community College associate degrees link most closely to the following Empire State College parallel bachelor's degree programs. With appropriate advising, the student can complete 79 lower-division credits (including those required for the associate degree) at Jamestown Community College which meet Empire State College requirements for any parallel bachelor's degree.

Listed horizontally are SUNY Empire State College bachelor's degrees. Listed vertically are Jamestown Community College associate degrees. Each box with an X indicates a Jamestown Community College associate degree and a parallel Empire State College bachelor's degree. Because of the individualized nature of Empire State College degrees, students may find that their associate degree could transfer well into other bachelor's degree programs not designated by this chart.
