Finalize your Financial Plan

File your FAFSA, apply for state aid and loans, and explore other financial aid options any time after October 1 for a fall start date. File by February 1 for priority consideration for grants and scholarships with limited funding. sunyjcc.edu/financialaid

Log in to Your Student Accounts

Learn about and log in to your JCC student accounts. Upon acceptance, you are able to access several of JCC systems (Banner, Degree Works, and Starfish) where you can view academic information, review and sign off on financial aid information, schedule appointments with advisors and more. Schedule an Advisement and Registration Appointment

Schedule an appointment with your advisor to begin building your course schedule. Advisement begins mid-April for the fall semester and late-October for the spring semester. To learn how to schedule an appointment with an advisor, visit sunyjcc.edu/newstudentadvisement

Attend a New Student Orientation

After you register for classes, sign up for new student orientation where you will make valuable connections to the resources you will need to succeed in your classes. New student orientation takes place in August, just before the start of the fall semester and in January, just before the start of the spring semester. sunyjcc.edu/orientation

View your Bill

In order to confirm your registration at JCC each semester, you must log in to Banner and view your student bill (refer to “**Log in to Your Student Accounts**” on this list). Once you have viewed your student bill, you have completed the electronic Financial Responsibility Agreement (FRA). If you are under 18, you must complete a paper FRA; the instructions and the form can be found at sunyjcc.edu/experience/support/business-office/bill

Submit Certificate of Residence

If you are a New York state resident, you must submit a valid certificate of residence every academic year in order to receive the in-state tuition rate. Steps to submit your COR are dependent upon the county in which you live. Instructions can be found at sunyjcc.edu/COR

Submit Immunization Records

Immunization records may be submitted to the health center any time before classes begin. sunyjcc.edu/healthcenter

Explore Housing Options

On-campus housing is available at JCC's Jamestown campus. Our Hillside Suites are apartment-style housing with four or five private, fully furnished bedrooms, living room, kitchen, dining area, and two full bathrooms. Priority deadline to apply for on-campus housing for fall semester is August 1. sunyjcc.edu/reslife

Order your Textbooks

The JCC Bookstore is affiliated with Barnes & Noble College with a physical store at the Jamestown Campus and a web store that services all student. Course materials/textbook information is available at least 30 days prior to the start of each semester; purchases using financial aid start seven days prior to each semester. Free shipping is offered for texts for two weeks at the start of each semester. sunyjcc.bncollege.com

Student ID Card

All students should acquire a SUNY JCC photo ID for access to recreational facilities and residential buildings, borrowing library materials, meal plan purchases, and as a form of positive ID. Students can either send in a "selfie" photo, using requirements in this link, or watch for times during the first weeks of classes when photos will be taken at Jamestown or Olean. sunyjcc.edu/experience/support/id-cards
