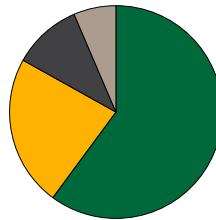

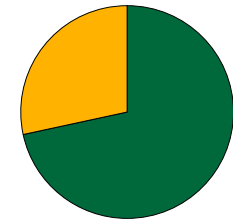

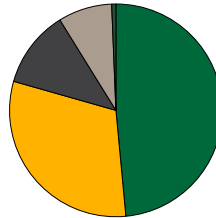
Student Status

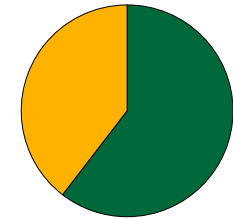

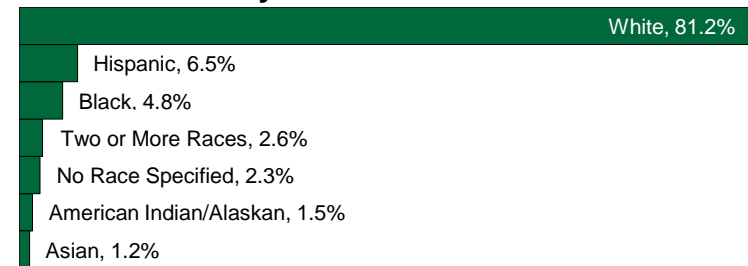

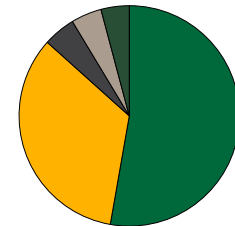

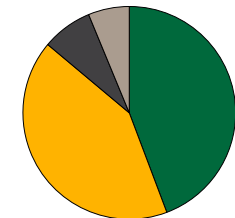
