

New Student Checklist

Congratulations on your acceptance to Jamestown Community College! Now that you've been accepted to JCC, you probably have questions as to what comes next. This checklist will help explain the next steps in the process & keep you on course toward registration for the upcoming semester. You can also find this information at sunyjcc.edu/nextsteps.

Log in to Your Student Accounts

Using the student user login information found on your acceptance letter, log into your student accounts at www.sunyjcc.edu/myjcc.

New Student Intake Form

Complete a short survey to help us address any needs you may have in regards to your time & education at JCC. sunyjcc.edu/advisement

Course Placement & Testing

Math & English placement is based on high school GPA & additional success indicators. Further placement testing may be required for students from out of state or without a GPA through junior year of high school. sunyjcc.edu/placementtesting.

Finalize your Financial Plan

File for financial aid any time after October 1 prior to the year you plan to start classes. File by January 1 for priority consideration for grants & scholarships with limited funding. sunyjcc.edu/financialaid

Meet with your Career Community Counselor

Schedule an appointment to work with your career community counselor to explore your interests, find information on careers & related college majors, & decide on the best career option for you. This is an optional step & can be completed at any time during the enrollment process. sunyjcc.edu/advisement

Advisement & Registration

Once registration is open, you may schedule an appointment with your advisor to begin building your course schedule. Typically, this is mid-April for the fall semester and late-October for the spring semester. To schedule an appointment, log in to your Starfish account (refer to first item on this list), or request an appointment through our Counseling Center. sunyjcc.edu/advisement

New Student Orientation

After you have scheduled your first semester, you will register for new student orientation, which will help you transition into collegiate life at JCC. Typically, new student orientation takes place late August, before the start of the fall semester. sunyjcc.edu/orientation

Certificate of Residence

If you are a New York state resident, you must submit a valid certificate of residence every academic year in order to receive the in-state tuition rate. Certificates are accepted by the business office in person or by mail no more than 60 days before the start of the semester. sunyjcc.edu/COR

Financial Responsibility Agreement (FRA)

In order to confirm your registration at JCC, you are required to complete & submit the FRA each semester by logging into Banner & viewing your student bill (refer to first item on this list).

Immunization Records

Submit your immunization records to the health center as soon possible to avoid a \$25 fine.
