

**A TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE
AND
DAEMEN COLLEGE
WITH
HEALTH PROMOTION – ANY SPECIALIZATION
CURRICULUM SHEET**

This agreement establishes guaranteed admission to Daemen College (Daemen) for students from Jamestown Community College (JCC). Upon completion of any JCC associate's degree specified in this agreement, students will be accepted with full junior standing into the specified parallel bachelor's degree program at Daemen. JCC students can complete the Daemen degree within four additional semesters by following the attached guide sheets. Some health-related and teacher certification curricula may require more than four semesters at Daemen. As additional parallel programs are added to this agreement, any such exceptions will be noted on the appropriate curriculum guide sheet.

Application to Daemen

Applicants to Daemen will be expected to meet the requirements for the appropriate associate's degree program at JCC.

Students may apply to Daemen under this articulation agreement when they are near, or have completed requirements for, their associate's degree at JCC. Any courses completed to date will be verified by Daemen as appropriate for the designated Daemen program.

Parallel Programs and Transfer of JCC Credits

Students may select any Daemen major designated below as parallel to a program at JCC. Depending on the Daemen degree selected, students can transfer up to the number of JCC credits noted below toward meeting Daemen degree requirements. See the curriculum sheets that accompany this agreement for details:

- AAS Business – Accounting/BS Accounting – 72 JCC credits
- AS Business – Business Administration/BS Business Administration – General Business Specialization – 90 JCC credits
- AAS Individual Studies/BS Health Promotion, Any Specialization – 60 JCC credits
- AS Liberal Arts & Sciences – Math & Science/BS Natural Science – Health Science Specialization – 72 JCC credits
- AAS Nursing – BS Nursing – 90 JCC credits
- AS Criminal Justice/BS Paralegal Studies – 84 JCC credits
- AA Liberal Arts & Sciences: Humanities/BS Paralegal Studies – 84 JCC credits
- AA Liberal Arts & Sciences: Social Sciences/BS Paralegal Studies – 84 JCC credits

Student Academic Advisement

JCC will assume responsibility for advising students who are interested in transferring to Daemen. Advisors will use the attached curriculum guide sheets as the mechanism for communicating Daemen degree requirements to students. These guides will be revised every two years or as needed due to curriculum changes.

Application Procedures

Students who anticipate enrolling at Daemen under the auspices of this articulation agreement must complete an online application or file a paper application with the Daemen Office of Admissions. For the Summer and Fall terms, the application must be filed by April 1; for the Spring terms it must be filed by November 1.

¹Student may take BIO1570 Principles of Biology (BIO109/L) or BIO 1575 Biology: A Molecular Approach rather than BIO1500. BIO1570 (BIO-109/L) & BIO1580 (BIO-110/L) are recommended if pursuing a graduate degree at Daemen.

²Student may take CHE1530 Allied Health Chemistry (CHE101) or CHE1550 College Chemistry I (CHE110/L) rather than CHE1500. CHE1550 (CHE-110L) & CHE1560 (CHE-111L) are recommended if pursuing a graduate degree at Daemen.

* Pending choice of Specialization (Community Health, Health and Fitness, or Complementary and Alternative Health Care Practices), courses may be adjusted to fulfill these requirements.

Daemen College will allow the transfer of up to 60 Jamestown Community College credits as specified above toward fulfillment of requirements for the B.S. Health Promotion, Any Specialization major. These DC requirements can be fulfilled by including the specified equivalent courses as electives for the JCC degree:

- BIO 207/7/BIO 208/L Anatomy & Physiology I/II (8 credits) = BIO 2510/BIO 2520 Anatomy & Physiology I/II (8 credits)
- One of these courses (3 credits):

CMP212 News Writing = ENG 2740 Newswriting and Editing
or
CMP312 Creative Writing = ENG 2540 Creative Writing
Or
CMP 318 Writing for Media = CMM 2530 Writing for Electronic Media
