PROGRAM-TO-PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN MANSFIELD UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA AND JAMESTOWN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Associate in Science in Fine Arts: Music to Bachelor of Arts in Music 2+2 Degree-completion Program

THIS AGREEMENT, dated this 15th day of February, 2016, is made by and between Mansfield University of Pennsylvania, an educational institution of the State System of Higher Education, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, (hereinafter called "MU"), and Jamestown Community College (hereinafter "JCC").

Both MU and JCC agree to cooperate in the articulation of students between institutions ultimately majoring in Music. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the educational progress of students by eliminating duplication of degree requirements where possible. This agreement also serves as the basis for guiding students as they develop their academic plans. This agreement is only applicable for students entering MU with the Associate in Science (AS) in Fine Arts: Music degree. Students transferring without the AS degree will have their transcripts evaluated by the MU department chairperson to determine the transferability of individual courses. A student who has earned an AS in Fine Arts: Music degree from JCC will be guaranteed admission into the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Music program, on the condition that they:

Graduate from JCC with a minimum QPA of 2.00 on a 4.0 scale.

Enroll at MU within one year of graduation from JCC.

Do not attend another institution of higher education between the time they graduate from JCC and enroll at MU.

Satisfy all conditions stated in this Agreement and all other regular MU admission requirements as published in the current MU college catalog.

Successfully pass a music audition through MU.

BA majors at MU must also complete either a 2nd year language proficiency or a minor.

Note: During the audition process prior to the first semester at MU, students will be evaluated on their piano ability, music theory knowledge, and aural skills aptitude. Students entering Mansfield University will be placed into the appropriate MU Basic Music and Piano courses based upon their performance on this audition.

NOW THEREFORE, MU and JCC officially confirm the following terms of this agreement:

- **a.** Admission of Transfer Student. At the beginning of their final semester at JCC, the student submits an application for admission as a transfer student to MU. Students are encouraged to apply early. Students will then be admitted into the BA Degree in Music major at MU.
- **b.** Acceptance into BA Degree Program. Upon formal admission to MU, the student must submit an appropriate advanced deposit that will be credited towards the first semester fees/tuition. The student will follow the curriculum requirements in effect at MU at the time of the student's

enrollment into MU's Music program and will thereafter comply with any changes to the curriculum at the discretion of MU.

- **c. Student Transcript.** The student must submit an official final transcript from JCC, verifying receipt of the AS in Fine Arts: Music degree, directly to MU prior to matriculating at MU. The student is responsible for all costs associated with the transcript.
- **d. MU Student Registration:** After acceptance into MU, the student registers for courses in accordance with MU's procedures. A process for advising prospective transfer students will be developed by MU's Department of Music.
- **e.** Transfer Credits. MU will accept toward meeting requirements for the BA Music degree a total of up to 67 credits from JCC which include 44-48 credits in general education/pre-requisite, co-requisite, & free electives, and 19 major credits with grades of "C-" or better as stated in (EXHIBIT A).
- **f. MU Transfer Advising.** The MU Music Department Chairperson or Academic Advisor will ensure that all transfer course equivalencies listed in "Exhibit A" are applied towards the student's MU academic record. The MU Department Chairperson or Academic Advisor will also contact the MU Registrar and ensure that the transfer equivalencies as listed in "Exhibit A" are awarded for students following this agreement for the purpose of satisfying the requisites and co-requisites of the Music major.
- **g.** University Requirements for the BA Degree: Students are expected to complete all stated MU Graduation Requirements and all other General Education, Pre-Requisite, and Major Field requirements as described in MU's catalog and other published Departmental policies in order to receive the BA in Music degree from MU.
- h. Opportunity to Earn the BA Degree: Students who are accepted into the BA in Music degree program and transfer a minimum of 54 JCC credits from the coursework listed in Exhibit A will have the opportunity to earn the BA in Music degree in four semesters at MU.
