RN to BSN and RN to BSN/MSN - Articulation Agreement

I. Introduction

This Articulation Agreement is for students enrolled at the Jamestown Community College State University of New York who identify interest in earning the Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science Nursing (RN to BSN) or Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science Nursing / Master Science Nursing (RN to BSN/MSN including the Case Management, Education, Informatics, Infection Prevention & Control, and Management & Organizational Leadership specializations) at Post University

Students participating in this Articulation Agreement will be eligible for enrollment in the Post University BSN or BSN/MSN program upon graduation from Jamestown Community College State University of New York and licensure as a registered nurse, provided that they satisfy conditions specified in this agreement.

Admissions and advising staffs at the sending and receiving institutions will work closely together and with participating students to ensure that appropriate coursework is completed and accepted upon transfer to Post University. Students participating in this articulation agreement will experience benefits that include:

- A. Early identification of interest in and preparation for advancement into the Post University online RN to BSN or RN to BSN/MSN program.
- B. Consistent, integrated academic advisement and support.
- C. Access to Post University student activities and campus facilities at the time of enrollment.
- D. Eligibility for enrollment in the RN to BSN or RN to BSN/MSN program at Post University pending completion of the Associates of Nursing degree, active and unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse and specified conditions listed below.
- E. Ability to transfer up to 90 credits from previous accredited colleges.
- F. Rolling admissions that permit application throughout the year and in all term starts.
- G. Smooth transition from the Jamestown Community College State University of New York to Post University.

II. Articulation Guidelines

- A. Students may apply to Post University's RN to BSN program or the RN to BSN/MSN program during any of the enrollment terms.
- B. Students participating in this articulation agreement will be eligible for enrollment as matriculated students in the BSN program at Post University upon completion of the Associate Degree, licensure as a registered nurse and satisfaction of the following conditions:
 - 1. Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.
 - 2. Proof of current, unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse.
 - 3. Students participating in this agreement will receive the transfer credits as indicated in the crosswalk below.
 - 4. Students are required to complete a minimum of 30 credits with Post University to earn their BSN degree.

5. Students participating in this agreement will matriculate under degree and residency requirements of the Post University catalog that are in effect when they are accepted into the RN to BSN Program or the RN to BSN/MSN Program at Post University.
6. Upon acceptance into the RN to BSN Program or the RN to BSN/MSN Program at Post University, students will be eligible to receive Post University student identification cards and associated privileges, including participation in student activities and college events and access to the Post University library, network center, and campus facilities.
7. Students will no longer be eligible for the benefits described in this Articulation agreement if they withdraw or are dismissed from the Jamestown Community College State University of New York, or transfer from the Jamestown Community College State University of New York to a college or university other than Post University.

III. Institutional Commitments

A. The responsibilities of the Jamestown Community College State University of New York are to:

1. Publicize the availability of the Articulation Agreement.
2. Make Post University application materials available to students interested in participating in this Articulation Agreement.
3. Advise Partner Program students interested in attending the Post University RN to BSN program or RN to BSN/MSN program. Identify prospective students interested in enrolling in the RN to BSN Program or the RN to BSN/MSN program and share the information with Post University.
4. Designate personnel to work with staff at Post University to implement an effective communication plan to interested students.
5. Work with Post University faculty to coordinate information sessions for prospective students.

B. The Responsibilities of Post University are to:

1. Designate an Admissions Advisor who will serve as the point of contact for students interested in, and admitted to, the RN to BSN Program or the RN to BSN/MSN program at Post University.
2. Work with Jamestown Community College State University of New York personnel to coordinate information sessions for prospective students.
3. Students from Jamestown Community College State University of New York that enter through this agreement will receive a 20% reduction in tuition.

The attached RN to BSN Articulation reflects enhancements/amendments based upon general education at Post University. As of the date of this signing, the Post University signature evidences university-level approval.
